Covenant with Jonathan

Saul angry, suspicious

The people were pleased

Christ, the Good Shepherd

The sheep hear His voice John 10

The Parable of the Lost Sheep, Luke 15

Jesus, the Lamb of God

Who takes away the sin of the worlds, John 1:29

Offered one sacrifice for sins once and for all

Through His own blood

Cleansing us Hebrews 10:10, 10:19-22

Shepherds in the Body of Christ

Instructions to Shepherds:

Tend my lambs, shepherd my sheep because you love Christ, John 21

Be on guard, for all the flock, wolves among you, admonish with tears, Acts 20

Exercise oversight, voluntarily, humbly, eagerly, as an example to the flock, in 1 Peter 5:1-4

Submission to Shepherds in the Body of Christ

Instructions to church members:

The body is to be in subjection to leaders, refresh the leader's spirit, acknowledge such men, 1 Corinthians 16:15-18

Members are to appreciate those who diligently labor among you, 1 Thessalonians 5:12,13
